H1N1 Clinics for the week of January 4th:

The following counties have scheduled H1N1 Flu Vaccine Clinics for this week – Philadelphia, Montgomery, Chester and Delaware counties. Bucks County has H1N1 Flu Vaccine Clinics scheduled for the week of January 11th.

Philadelphia County:

The vaccine is available to walk-in patients, on a first-come basis, during the hours and dates listed on the website. The information on the site is updated often. **THE H1N1 VACCINE IS NOW AVAILABLE TO ANYONE WHO WANTS IT.**

Montgomery County:

The Montgomery County Health Department has scheduled two walk-in H1N1 flu clinics for **ANY** resident who would like to decrease their risk of contracting the H1N1 virus. The clinics will be held:

- Friday, January 8th, 2010 from 2pm to 5pm at Trinity Lutheran church, 1000 W. Main Street, Lansdale, PA, 19446.
- Saturday, January 9th, 2010 from 10am to 1pm at Plymouth Whitmarsh High School, 201 E. Germantown Pike, Plymouth Meeting, PA.

Bucks County:

The Bucks County Health Department has scheduled the following dates and times for **ANY** resident who would like to obtain the H1N1 vaccine. The clinics will be held at:

- Friday, January 15 from 4 to 7 pm at Council Rock North High School, 62 Swamp Road, Newtown
